(100% stake) is a leading global reinsurer with headquarters in Pembroke (Bermuda). PartnerRe controls 100% of the common stock.



(22.91% stake) began operations on 3 January 2016 following the completion of a series of transactions to separate the operations of Ferrari from those of CNH Industrial.

(20.89% stake) is listed on the New York Stock Exchange (NYSE) and the Mercato Telematico Azionario managed by Borsa Italiana (MTA).
